

OCTOBERAMA DIAMONDS QUILT

Octoberama Diamonds is a new layout option that features two directions of "leaves" creating a cool diamond pattern. This expansion to our block pattern will give you the fabric requirements and background fabric cutting for 24 blocks and to and the quilt design below. *Note that the measurements in the mock up are finished and do not have the seam allowance added.*

Fabrics featured are Charley Harper Harvest 2023.

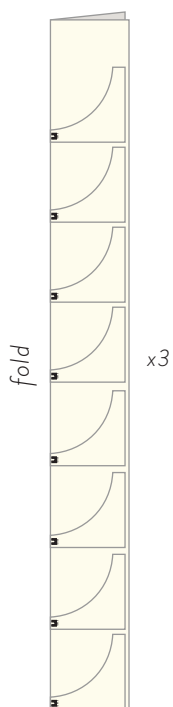
OCTOBERAMA DIAMONDS QUILT

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 9 fat quarters for main prints
- 3½ yds of background fabric
- ¾ yds binding fabric
- 4 yds backing fabric

CUTTING

1. Cut (6) 3" x WOF strips. Sew strips together on the short sides and sub cut into:
 - (2) 3" x 57"
 - (2) 3" x 55"
2. Cut (3) 4" x WOF strips, sub cut into
 - (9) 4" x 8.5" pieces
3. Cut (6) 9" x WOF strips, sub cut into
 - (48) 5" x 9" pieces and (6) 2.25" x 8.5" pieces.
4. Use the additional 1 yard for cutting your curve pieces. Cut (3) 10" x WOF strips. Fold fabric in half lengthwise so that it measures 5" x WOF. Cut the template on the fold. You should yeild (8) leaf curves per WOF.



Use the Octoberama Leaf Block instructions to complete (24) blocks, taking care the direction of your finished leaves and the orientation of your fabric. Use the diagram on page 7 to assemble your quilt top. All seam allowance is ¼". Quilt and bind as desired.
